Guidance

In light of it not being law to isolate it is still guidance to isolate and stay at home to protect others. Please adhere to government guidance.

Our Playgroup Policy will continue until further notice.

Guidance is to stay home if you are positive for at least 5days. You can return after 2 negative tests.

If you are too poorly to play then please stay at home.

Children must not have Calpol before coming to Playgroup. This is very important as can mask a more serious illness such as meningitis. In an emergency situation we need to let paramedics know if they've had medicine.

If children develop a high temperature they will be sent home. A normal temperature for children is around 37. A common sense approach will be in place and children who have been running around or don't appear poorly will be checked again after 20mins.

If a child has had continuous doses of Calpol the day before a Playgroup session please keep them off for 24hours to ensure they are well enough to be in.

If you have any of the main 3 symptoms of covid please do a test and stay away from Playgroup.

We have a duty to report positive cases to the Local Authority so please continue to let us know, even in the holidays.

If you test positive yourself please do not come onto playgroup grounds until you have 2 negative tests 24hours apart.
