# Continuation of winter bugs

As you are all aware we are in the midst of the winter season with all the usual germs that are going around. In addition to the normal winter colds and vomiting bugs, we are experiencing higher than usual incidents of Flu, Strep A infections and a rise in Covid infections. Because of this, we have instituted some extra hygiene measures to mitigate the risks of catching and passing on infections.

We would also like to say that if your child requires Calpol before attending they are most likely not well enough to attend and they probably have an infection that they can pass on to others.

Please do not send your child when they have had Calpol and please make sure that your child is in good health when they return to playgroup.

Children who have a fever should be kept at home until 24 hours after the temperature has returned to normal.


As a setting we will be particularly vigilant and will notify you as soon as we suspect that your child is unwell.

Please support us in our efforts by reinforcing this good hand hygiene at home as well. I would also like to remind you that if your child has vomiting and diarrhoea they must be kept at home until 48 hours after the last loose stool or vomiting episode.
