Lets hope 2022 enables us to be able to do more fun things!

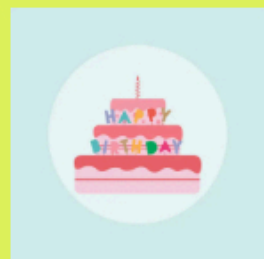
